

**BLASTING GUIDELINES FOR
CITY OF UNION CITY**

Blasting permits/applications are presently being issued from the Union City Permit Division of the City of Union City, located at 5047 Union Street, Union City, Georgia 30291. The City of Union City and Union City Fire Department has adopted Fire Prevention Code (2003 Edition), Rules and Regulations of the State of Georgia 120-3-10, O.C.G.A. Title 25, and N.F.P.A. 495.

The Union City Permit Division must have a copy of your current Georgia State License, Federal License, Business License, and proof of insurance on file prior to the issuance of an Explosive/Blasting Permit within the jurisdiction of the City of Union City.

The permit fee for blasting is \$200.00 per job and the permit is only good for a period of 60 days from date of issue.

The permit will be for the date notated and is not transferable. It will be the contractor/blasters responsibility to obtain a permit prior to any blasting in Union City and the permit or copy is to remain on the site during blasting. Prior to issuance of a permit, the applicant will furnish the Union City Permit Division with proper identification (drivers' license), a copy of which will remain in the permit file. Blasting will only be conducted during daylight hours and **NO** blasting will be conducted on Sundays or holidays unless approved by the Union City Fire Marshal's Office.

Before any blast/shot can be conducted, the responsible person on site must contact the Union City Communications Center at 770-964-1333 (Non-Emergency Line), 15 minutes prior to the blast/shot.

Some site locations may require additional procedures such as traffic control, etc. Specific sites may need to be discussed prior to receiving a permit, with the Union City Fire Marshal or his/her designee. Additional cost may be involved.

On site observation of blast site may be done at the discretion of the Fire Marshal's Office. If a member of our staff is not on site at your scheduled blast time you may continue. If we find that you are blasting at times other those scheduled by your phone call or if you fail to call in times for your blasts, Union City reserves the right to suspend your permit until corrective measures are discussed with the Fire Marshal's Office of Union City.


If any complaints are received by the City of Union City during your blasting, the responsible party listed on your permit/application will be notified immediately and your permit will be placed on a hold status until the complaint is fully investigated by the Union City Fire Marshal and your Company. Only the Fire Marshal's Office staff may release the permit for continued blasting.

The holder of "**Blaster Competency Card**", issued by the Safety Fire Commissioner, must be on site at all times. The proper certification level will apply.

A full blasting report will be submitted back to the Union City Permit Division upon completion of the job for proper filing.
