



UC NEWS UPDATE

February 6, 2014

Union City –The National Weather Service is reporting that an upper level disturbance will move across Mississippi and Alabama today and gradually spread moisture across Georgia by this afternoon. Light rain is expected to develop from Columbus to Macon after noon (est) and spread north to the Atlanta Metro Area during the afternoon hours. Temperatures will be in the low to mid 40s which will result in just a cold rain. However, after sunset, as the rain continues, temperatures will gradually fall into the mid 30's with light snow possibly mixing with the rain briefly before ending by midnight. The wintry mix will be generally along and north of a line from Columbus to Louisville, but is expected to be limited to a few hours. This will include the Atlanta Metro Area and any snow should melt quickly after hitting the ground. This is a far different scenario

from last week with temperatures remaining above freezing while the precipitation is falling. Also, lighter amounts of precipitation will further limit any accumulation potential. The greatest concern will be thin patches of black ice tonight as temperatures fall into the 20s by sunrise. Motorists are urged to use caution and slow down until the roadways have an opportunity to dry out.

Our Public Services & Public Safety Departments are standing by and watching weather forecasts and are prepared to react as needed.
