### **Union City Welcomes New Distribution Facility that will Create Over 600 Jobs**

**UNION CITY, GA**-The City of Union City announced that there is a new regional distribution center in Union City, GA, which will distribute **Procter & Gamble (P&G)** products to customers in the southeast. The new site will bring over 600 jobs to the region.

This site serves as a build-to-suite development for a 1-plus million-square-foot distribution center and office complex and as a new addition to the existing Majestic Airport Center III Industrial Park. The \$60 million facility, a cross-dock-loading distribution center that also includes 50,000 square feet of office space, is finalizing construction on a prominent site fronting I-85, approximately eight miles south of the Hartsfield-Jackson Atlanta International Airport.

Mayor Vince Williams was elated. "This announcement makes a clear statement that the City Council stands ready to work with our business community. We are rebranding ourselves as an economic powerhouse in the region. The strategic decision to build a distribution center here translates into real jobs and real job opportunities for our residents."

The facility is owned by MAJESTIC AIRPORT CENTER III PHASE TWO, LLC, and leased by THE PROCTER & GAMBLE DISTRIBUTING LLC. The facility will have a few P&G managers on site, although two companies, Quality Associates (QA) and Exel Inc., will run the site's overall operations. QA and Exel will fill positions for site managers, administrative support, forklift operators, and material handlers, noted spokeswoman Lynn Anderson. "We will manage and operate the distribution center's activities." Exel operates about 25 additional P&G centers in the United States and South America. Quality Associates Inc., which specializes in packaging, will also serve an essential role in the daily functions of the site's production. According to the company's representative, Steve Bowden, Quality Associates will hire a large number of employees as well.

"This development began in November of last year and to have it completed within 12 months of construction is a remarkable testament," said Mayor Williams. "This new facility is evidence that Union City is Open for Business!"
