

Union City Restores Historic Water Tower

Union City's water tower, one of the city's oldest landmarks recently received a much need renovation. The water tower, located at the intersection of Harris and Watson Street, is a 60,000 gallon water storage tank. The tower currently does not store water, but it had begun to blister, crack, rust and deteriorate from years of sun exposure.



The City hired a utility service company to makeover the historic landmark. The company began restoring the water tower by sand blasting the deteriorating paint and other debris from the structure, repainting the water tower and completing it with a new city logo. A historic landmark which was once an eyesore for many years now is restored and will be preserved for years to come.
